

2016 Undergraduate Summer Scholarships

The University of Southern California Chapter of Phi Kappa Phi invites undergraduate students to apply for a scholarship to support research or creative projects during the summer of 2016.

Award amount: Up to \$1,000.

Eligibility: Any student who is a sophomore or junior at the University of Southern California during the Spring 2016 semester and has a minimum 3.25 cumulative grade point average is eligible to apply.

Materials to Submit: Applicants must submit the following:			
	4 copies of the completed application form (next page)		
	4 copies of the one page project proposal		
	1 copy of transcripts for all post-secondary coursework		
	1 letter endorsing the student project from a USC faculty member		

The project proposal should provide information on the following points: i) project title, ii) nature of the project and its significance, and iii) plan for completing the project, including the specific goals, planned procedure, budget, and timeline.

Students' project cannot be tied to research or a creative project that is being conducted by a professor (i.e. the student cannot be the professor's assistant on the project).

Deadline & Submission Address: The deadline for submission of applications is **April 4, 2016 by 5:00 pm**. Application materials should be submitted in hard copy to the following location:
