2016 Undergraduate Summer Scholarship

- Awards of up to \$1,000 to support research or creative projects that awardees will undertake during summer 2016.
- Open to USC sophomores and juniors (as of spring 2016) with a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA; Phi Kappa Phi membership **is not** required.
- The 2016 summer scholarship application form is attached.
- The USC chapter office listed below must receive completed applications in hardcopy no later than **5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 4, 2016**.

2016 Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship for First-Year Graduate or Professional Study

- Open to Phi Kappa Phi members who will begin their first year of graduate or professional study between May 1, 2016, and February 1, 2017.
- USC PKP will select recipients of the:
 - **Local chapter fellowship**; number of recipients and amounts of awards vary each year
 - **Carl and Sterling Franklin Phi Kappa Phi Scholarship**
 - **National fellowship** (\$5,000-\$15,000)
- The 2016 fellowship application form is attached. Only **one** application is needed for consideration for all awards listed above.
