At minimum, the student must declare a preliminary three-person committee, consisting of a primary advisor and two other members, by the end of the semester in which they pass screening (typically this deadline will be in December of the student's second year). D-clearance for classes for the following semester (typically spring) will be withheld until this preliminary committee is formally established; any late registration fees or other penalties resulting from this policy are the responsibility of the student, and will not be waived except under extraordinary circumstances that the student can neither anticipate nor control.*
