CONTRACT TO TAKE A COMMUNICATION MANAGEMENT, PUBLIC DIPLOMACY OR
JOURNALISM (CMGT/PUBD/JOUR) COURSE FOR PH.D. CREDIT

Explanation & Instructions:

Doctoral students wishing to enroll in a CMGT, PUBD or JOUR course for Ph.D. credit must complete this form and obtain the required signatures prior to registering for the class. Many CMGT, PUBD and JOUR classes cover topics and materials of interest to doctoral students. However, most CMGT, PUBD and JOUR classes are practically oriented and do not contain the research focus appropriate to doctoral classes. For this reason, students wishing to apply such classes to their doctoral programs must perform additional research oriented work. Normally, this additional work will consist of additional theoretically driven readings, and a research oriented seminar level paper. Instructors should evaluate this work according to the rigorous standards appropriate to doctoral level work. NOTE: Normally a doctoral student may take no more than two such CMGT, PUBD or JOUR classes, and **no more than one** may count toward the student's track requirement. These limitations **do not apply**, and this contract is **not needed**, for the following courses, which are cross-listed in the Ph.D. curriculum: CMGT 530, CMGT 531, CMGT 537, CMGT 581, CMGT 582, CMGT 583, CMGT 587, CMGT 588, PUBD 504, PUBD 510, PUBD 515, PUBD 516, and PUBD 522.
