

SPRING 2026 UNDERGRADUATE ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT

All U1 and U2 Annenberg majors, plus those recently admitted to the school, have an advisement requirement and must meet with an advisor to register for Spring 2026 classes.

Pre-Registration Advising appointments are scheduled based on class standing, which reflects the number of units **COMPLETED** and does not include current enrollment. The Schedule of Classes and your Spring 2026 registration time will be available on October 6.

<u>Continuing U3 and U4 Annenberg students</u>: You are <u>NOT</u> required to meet with your advisor. You will receive an updated course plan via Advise USC by October 3 and your advising hold will be lifted. If you would like to meet with an advisor, we encourage you to attend Virtual Drop-Ins (you may also make an advising appointment).

<u>Scheduling an appointment:</u> A link to schedule your advisement appointment online will be sent to your USC email account on the first day you can schedule your appointment, based on class standing.

<u>Appointment Policy:</u> You will be able to schedule one appointment. If you cannot make your meeting, please reschedule via the link at least 24 hours before. If you are late by 10 minutes, miss your appointment, or cancel with less than 24-hour notice, you may schedule one more appointment during the Pre-Registration Advising period. If you miss that appointment as well, you will be required to wait until after <u>November 7</u> to re-schedule.

<u>Virtual Drop-In Advising:</u> Every Wednesday from October 8 - November 12 from 10am-12pm and 1:30-3:30pm, there will be virtual drop-in advising to answer follow-up questions (NOT to meet the advisement requirement). You must sign up 30 minutes prior to drop-ins concluding (11:30am & 3pm).

<u>Non-Major Information:</u> Non-majors should create a referral within AdviseUSC for the Annenberg program of interest and mark themselves as "Ready for Advising." They will be assigned a referral advisor to whom they can direct their questions after November 7.
