APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications will be available on our website in May for Spring study abroad. Students must submit: resume, essay and letter of recommendation.

ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- At least a sophomore standing at the start of the program
- Open to all majors

ESTIMATED COSTS*

- Tuition: \$10,375 (Spring 2018 rate)
- Housing: \$8,400
- Program Fees: \$3,000
- USC Overseas Health Insurance (required): \$1,311
- Round Trip Airfare: \$1,800
- Personal Expenses (food, travel, etc.): \$5,000
